- 4. The contest year shall run from the previous May to the date of the Massachusetts Sheep and Wool Craft Fair. All applications are due **May 1st.**
- 5. The selected applicants will be scheduled to be interviewed prior to the Massachusetts Sheep & Wool Craft Fair.
- 6. Selection of this award is based on your interview and a written application. The following are some of the points considered:

Application must be complete and specific and show growth in the project. All requested information should be attached to this application. If selected for an interview, your 4-H or FFA records may be brought/sent with you on the day of the interview.
