Baystate Organic Certifiers 2015 Fee Summary for New Applicants

In General

Baystate Organic Certifiers has a specific mission to provide low-cost certification services to operations of any size. Unlike many other certifying agents, we charge one all-inclusive application fee that combines the certification fee and the cost of the annual certification inspection. Baystate certifies operations primarily in CT, DE, MD, MA, ME, NH, NJ, NY, OH, PA, RI, VA and VT. For operations in these states, we do not charge a separate inspection fee.

Application Fees and Fee Reimbursement

All operations must pay an annual fee based on the projected gross value of the certified products handled by the operation. New operations pay an additional \$150 fee in their 1st year only.

Each state government has Federal money available to refund organic certification fees, up to 75% of total fees or \$750, whichever is less. The fee schedule for all types of operations is as follows:

Copying Fee

Two copies of every application must be submitted. If an applicant does not submit the original plus a copy, a \$30 copying fee is charged. This fee is waived for applications submitted electronically.

Partial Payment of Fees

We realize that farming operations may not be able to afford the entire certification fee in the offseason. Therefore, growers have the option to defer paying up to 50% of their new or renewal certification fee until later in the year as long as they apply by June 15. Refunding Fees

For new operations only, applications can be withdrawn and fees partially refunded only if the application is withdrawn before the inspection is performed. See application materials for details.
